- 1) Project L.E.A.R.N. (Liquor Enforcement And Reduction of Noise): Beginning September 3rd, the London Police Service's CORE Unit will have a visible presence in student neighborhoods. Last year they charged 1460 students with various municipal, provincial and criminal, in the first five weeks of school! The majority of these charges were for excessive noise, unlawful assembly and having open alcohol in public, to name a few. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated this year, there will be no warnings!
- 2) Noise by-law: The city of London recently enacted a 24 hour noise by-law which means you can be fined at any time of the day for excessive noise making. This by-law has also been changed so that no complaint has to be filed. If you are playing music too loud, or if a group of students is making too much noise as defined by police, you will be charged. Fines are \$175 for the first offence and \$500 for a second offence. All concurrent offences are doubled. An example: If you are in a residence for two years, the first offence may happen in the fall of year one, the second fine continues until you vacate the premises.
