- 1. A 600-800 word essay answering the following questions:
 - a. How are you an advocate?
 - b. Why are you passionate about advocating for others?
 - c. Where do you hope to take your advocacy in the future?
- 2.Two (2) reference letters of the applicant's choice, who can attest to your advocacy and why you are deserving of the scholarship.

Qualifications:

- Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a post-secondary program at a CSA member campus.
- Individuals <u>do not qualify</u> for the scholarship if they are on the Board of Directors of a CSA member student association.
- Applicants must be or have been an advocate for students on-campus or in the community. Advocacy for others could fall in one or more of the following categories:
 - Indigenous students
 - International students
 - I GBTO+ students
 - Mature students
 - Students with disabilities
 - Students with financial needs
 - Other (please define)
